Voluntary Contributions and Charges 2024

Dear Parents and Carers

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents and carers of all contributions and charges prior to the start of the school year. These costs are divided into four areas: Voluntary Contributions, Charges, Personal Use Items and Extra Cost Optional Components that have been endorsed by the Palmyra School Council.

- 1. **Voluntary Contributions** A voluntary contribution towards the cost of items used in the educational program provided for your child.
- 2. Charges for extra cost optional components these are an estimated amount for charges for non-compulsory activities, which require payment as a condition of participation by students.
- 3. Personal Use Items required for use in the educational program e.g., stationery items.
- 4. Extra Cost Options available to students if families wish to participate.

1. Voluntary Contributions (Kindergarten to Year 6)

The total amount of Voluntary Contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay is **\$60.00 per student**. This equates to approximately \$1.50 per week. While Contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family contributes to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

The funds collected will be used to supplement expenditure in any of the following areas:

\$10 Library books/resources \$20 Literacy resources \$20 Mathematics resources

\$5 Physical Education resources \$5 Performing and Visual Arts materials

ICT Contribution (Pre-Primary to Year 6) \$15 per student

iPad Management and software purchases eg; Mathletics

Student Support Contribution (Kindergarten to Year 6) \$15 per student

Student Wellbeing Resources, eg; sensory tools

2. Charges for extra cost optional components

This amount can vary from year to year and from class to class. A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in excursions/in-school activities etc. for 2024 has been outlined in the schedule below. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **maximum** charged for scheduled activities in 2024. **Students can only participate if they have parental permission and have paid the charge.** This amount would cover the following activities: *Visiting performers, in-school activities, excursions, interschool sport, etc.*

The school receives a small commission from the supplier for each order received. If you wish your order to be processed by **Campion Education**, please complete the Personal Use Items List.
